Sending large files through email can be challenging. There are a few ways to get around this problem. UH FileDrop (www.hawaii.edu/filedrop) will allow you to send large files up to 999MB. You will need your UH Username and password to access the tool. Another option would be to upload the file to your Google Drive and then send your recipient a link to those files on your drive. After you have uploaded the files to Google Drive, click on Compose in Gmail. Then look for the Drive icon. You can choose your file and then click Insert to add the link. 
