Exercise and Sport Science

Starting in Fall 2013 and not to exceed Spring 2015, Kapi'olani Community College will stop accepting majors in the A.S. in Exercise and Sport Science.

During the stop out, the program will re-examine the curricular pathway to the workforce and possible restructuring of the program as a transfer pathway to the Kinesiology and Leisure Science baccalaureate program at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa.

Current students will be allowed to graduate under the existing A.S. in Exercise and Sport Science curriculum. The program coordinator will contact current students to inform them of the stop out and reassure them that they will be able to graduate as Exercise and Sport Science majors. Students who may have applied for the Fall intake will be counseled to change their majors and take General Education courses that also meet requirements for transfer to UHM's Kinesiology program.

The A.S. in Exercise and Sport Science is currently a provisional program. We hereby request an extension of its provisional status as we work through the curricular modifications that may result in the submission of a request to terminate the program and replace it with an Associate of Arts degree in Liberal Arts with a concentration in Exercise and Sport Science. The program has been

through many changes, from an open-admission program to a select admission program. It has also undergone substantial curricular revision. Our expectation is that this stop out will allow the program coordinator and other faculty to focus on developing an effective and efficient program.
