Parking Permit Requests for the Fall 2015 Semester will be available beginning Monday, August 17, 2015.

Lecturers, part time casual/89 hires, and contractors will no longer be issued a parking permit.

To request a Parking Permit, please fill out the Parking Permit Request Form in full (incomplete forms will NOT be accepted) and submit it to the Campus Operations Office in Room F201. Please have the form filled out prior to coming to the Campus Services Office. Current Parking Permits will be considered "Expired" beginning Friday, August 24, 2015.

Campus Services would like to ask for your assistance regarding the following items:

- 1. Starting Thursday, August 20, all Faculty and Staff with permits are required to park in designated stalls within the Faculty and Staff side of the parking lot (A1). Faculty and Staff should not be parking in the student side of the lot.
- 2. Only authorized vehicles are allowed to park in the Campus Center loading dock.
- 3. All loading docks should be used only for active loading and unloading.
- 4. There should be NO PARKING in the fire lanes.
