## Dr. Linda Furuto's Ethnomathematics Summer Institute featured in UH System video

The UH West O'ahu Ethnomathematics Summer Institute, spearheaded by Dr. Linda Furuto, was featured in a UH System video highlighting the popular summer program. The video shows participants taking part in a field study to the Hawai'i Institute of Marine Biology (HIMB) on Coconut Island in Kaneohe Bay, interviews with UH West O'ahu students, and still photos taken by our very own Stacey Sawa. Now in its fifth year, the Ethnomathematics Summer Institute allows University of Hawai'i faculty, staff and students to design and implement mathematics grounded in the ethnic, historical and cultural diversities of Hawai'i. In addition to HIMB, institute scholars participate in field studies to the Mokauea Fishing Village in Ke'ehi Lagoon, Polynesian Voyaging Society, and Kalaupapa on the island of Moloka'i. The resulting research and practicum-based textbook may be used by current educators to supplement mathematics curriculum, and future teachers as training material.
