16, once again in a hybrid format.

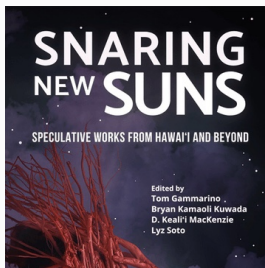

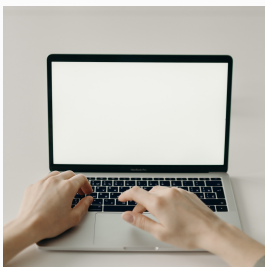
