### New degrees, concentrations, certificate make appearance for Fall 2019 Semester

UH West O'ahu has added two new degree programs, and five new concentrations for the Fall 2019 semester, along with a new certificate in Gender Studies. UH West O'ahu now has eight degree/major programs with 43 concentrations and eight certificates.

The new degree/majors are:

- Bachelor of Arts in Creative Media. Concentrations include General Creative Media, Communications and New Media Technologies, Design and Media, and Video Game Design and Development.
- Bachelor of Science in Natural Science. This is the campus' first federally recognized STEM degree.
   Several concentrations are planned, but one is being offered at this time Applied Mathematics.

A new Concentration in Long-Term Care will be offered in the fall semester as part of Bachelor of Arts in Public Administration students.
