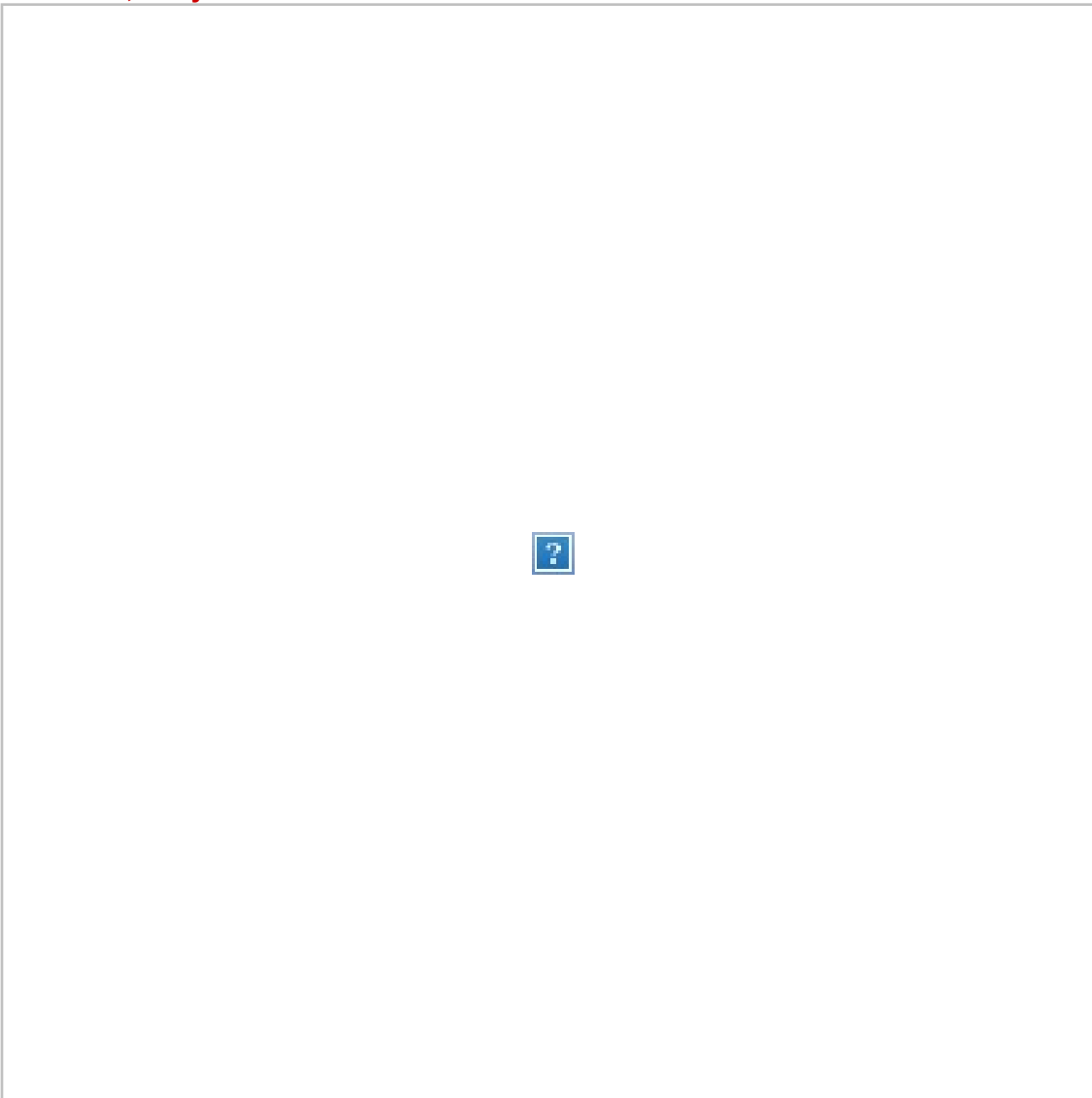

Rosenfeld's meeting is scheduled for Monday, April 30 from 11 a.m. to noon in D104.

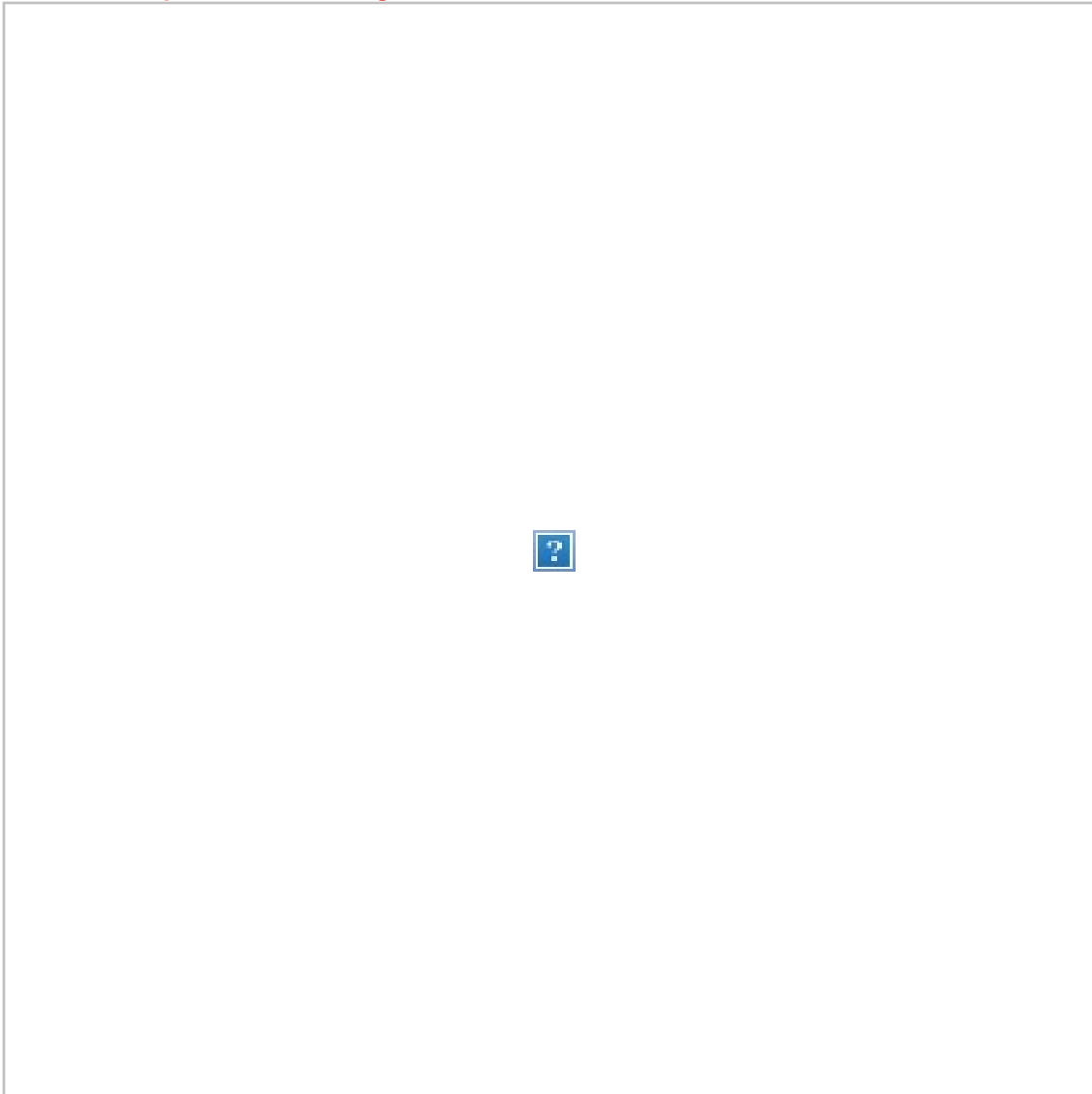
Choy's meeting is set for Wednesday, May 2, from 11 a.m. to noon in D104.

The AVCAA will oversee implementation of all faculty personnel processes, policies, and procedures as well as provide counsel and advice to the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and the Chancellor on all faculty personnel matters and provide leadership to develop new faculty personnel policies and procedures for the campus, according to a recruitment advertisement placed on ChronicleVitae.com.

Upcoming File Server upgrade to affect all network drives

UHWO Information Technology will be performing a file server upgrade starting on May 11 at 5 p.m. The upgrade will affect all network drives including your i:, j:, k:, l:, and m: drives. ITS will be freezing the data on those drives starting at 5 p.m., Friday, May 11, and will be available again on Monday, May 14, starting at 7 a.m. Freezing the data means that you will not be able to access the files so please complete all your work and save your files before 5 p.m. on Friday, May 11. This upgrade will not affect any files stored on Google Drive.

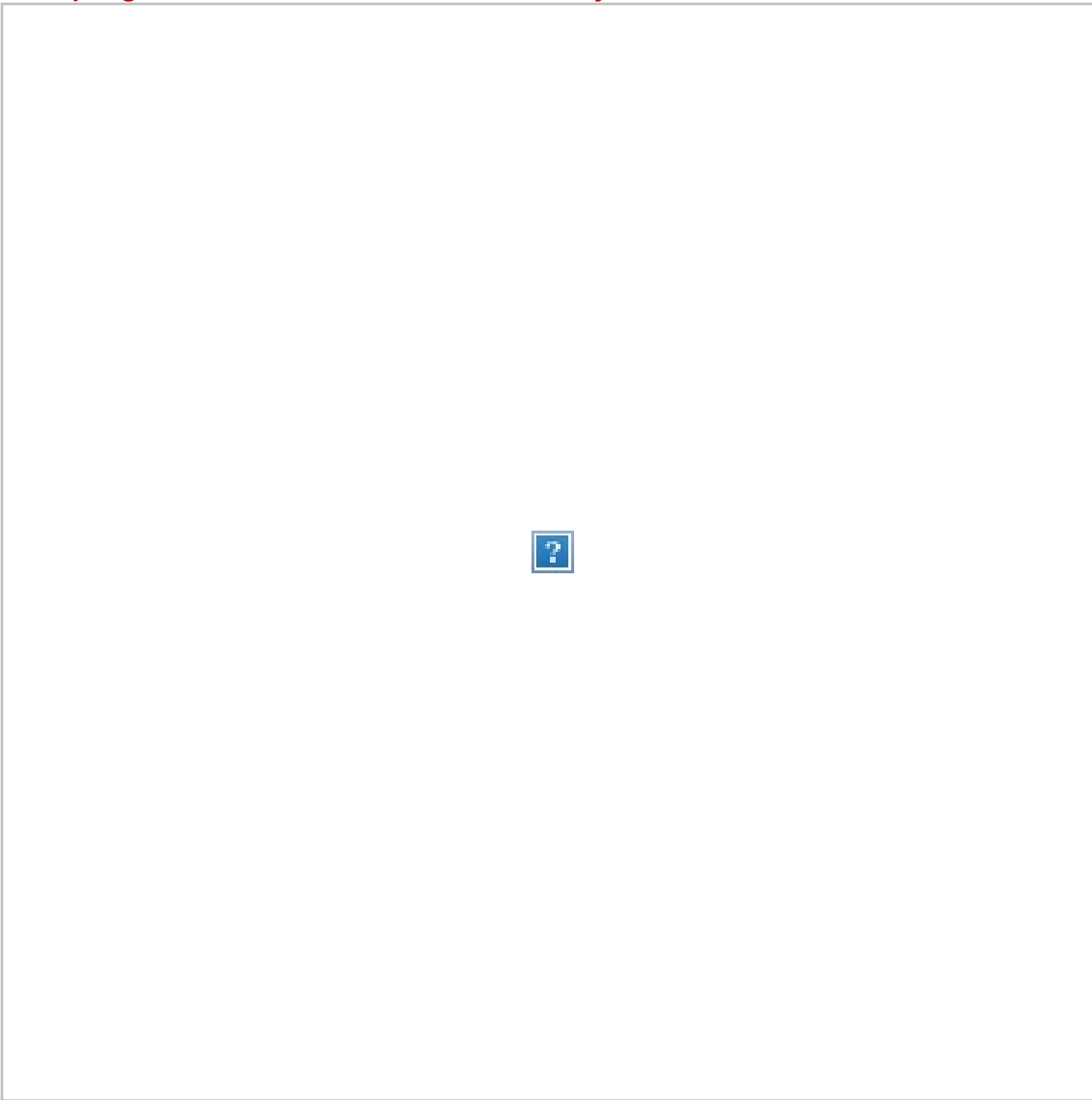

Just how does UH West O‘ahu stack up to its peers? You can find out because there’s a dashboard with that information, courtesy of the Office of Institutional Research. The new [benchmarking dashboard](#) was developed by undergraduate research assistant (and UHWO student!), Christi Palacat. The new dashboard uses federally reported IPEDS data and allows you to quickly compare UHWO to a group of similarly sized, public four-year baccalaureate colleges in the U.S. Simply click on a category of IPEDS data and the chart and text boxes will update automatically.

Study abroad opportunities at Incheon, Tongmyong universities

UH West O‘ahu students can apply for a summer or fall semester in South Korea, courtesy of study abroad opportunities. The offerings are in keeping with UH West O‘ahu’s effort to increase international studies on campus. Today (Monday, April 30) is the deadline to apply for the four-week program at [Incheon National University](#); the deadline for the 16-week program at [Tongmyong University](#) is June 10. Credits earned in the programs can be transferred to UH West O‘ahu as elective credits.

Work on the fixed-rail project will result in a shutdown of the makai-bound lanes of Kualaka'i Parkway between 8:30 a.m. and 3 p.m., Thursday May 3, as work crews install the pedestrian walkway at the Keone'ae (UH West O'ahu) rail station. The makai-bound lanes will be closed between Farrington Highway and Keahumoa Parkway.

Makai-bound traffic on Kualaka'i will be diverted on to Farrington Highway near the campus as part of a planned detour of traffic.
