The Monitoring Assessment Panel (MAP) is an independent, external review body that is recruited by the PI to monitor, assess, and critique the progress of Hawaii EPSCoR including the IMUA III award. The 6-member MAP is tasked with conducting annual site visits to participating campuses to assess the progress being made towards attaining project goals. In past visits, they have assisted in identifying institutional barriers to success and have offered suggestions based on the experience of other institutions. The MAP is a group of senior, established scientists that understand the capacity-building aspects of EPSCoR RIII awards and have the experience and knowledge in many of the subject areas of focus in IMUA III.
