Kualaka'i Parkway traffic to be affected again - closure set for Wednesday, May 9



The mauka-bound lanes of Kualaka'i Parkway will be closed between Farrington Highway and Keahumoa Parkway on from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Wednesday, May 9. Work crews will be installing a pedestrian bridge at the Keone'ae (UH West O'ahu) rail station. Similar work was performed on May 2, when the makai-bound lanes of Kualaka'i were closed for several hours.

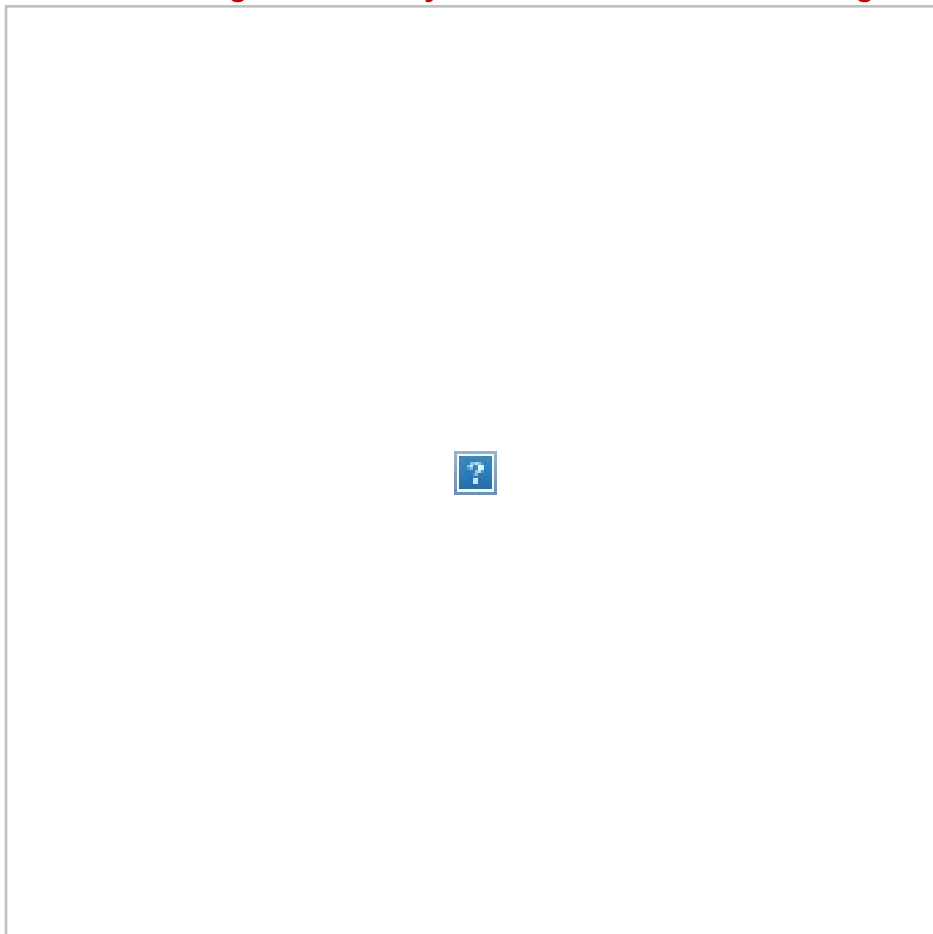

ITS will be freezing the data on those drives starting at 5 p.m., Friday, May 11, and will be available again on Monday, May 14, starting at 7 a.m.

Distance Learning Tip of the Week

Adding a profile picture to your Google account can be helpful to recipients when communicating online through the Google Apps such as Gmail or Google Hangouts. It can be a helpful reminder to see a small picture of your organization logo, your portrait, or an image that represents you. You can add a picture by clicking on the Settings icon, which looks like a gear. In the General tab, scroll down to My picture and click on Select a picture. You can upload a picture from your computer and resize the picture if necessary. When you are ready, click on Apply Changes.
