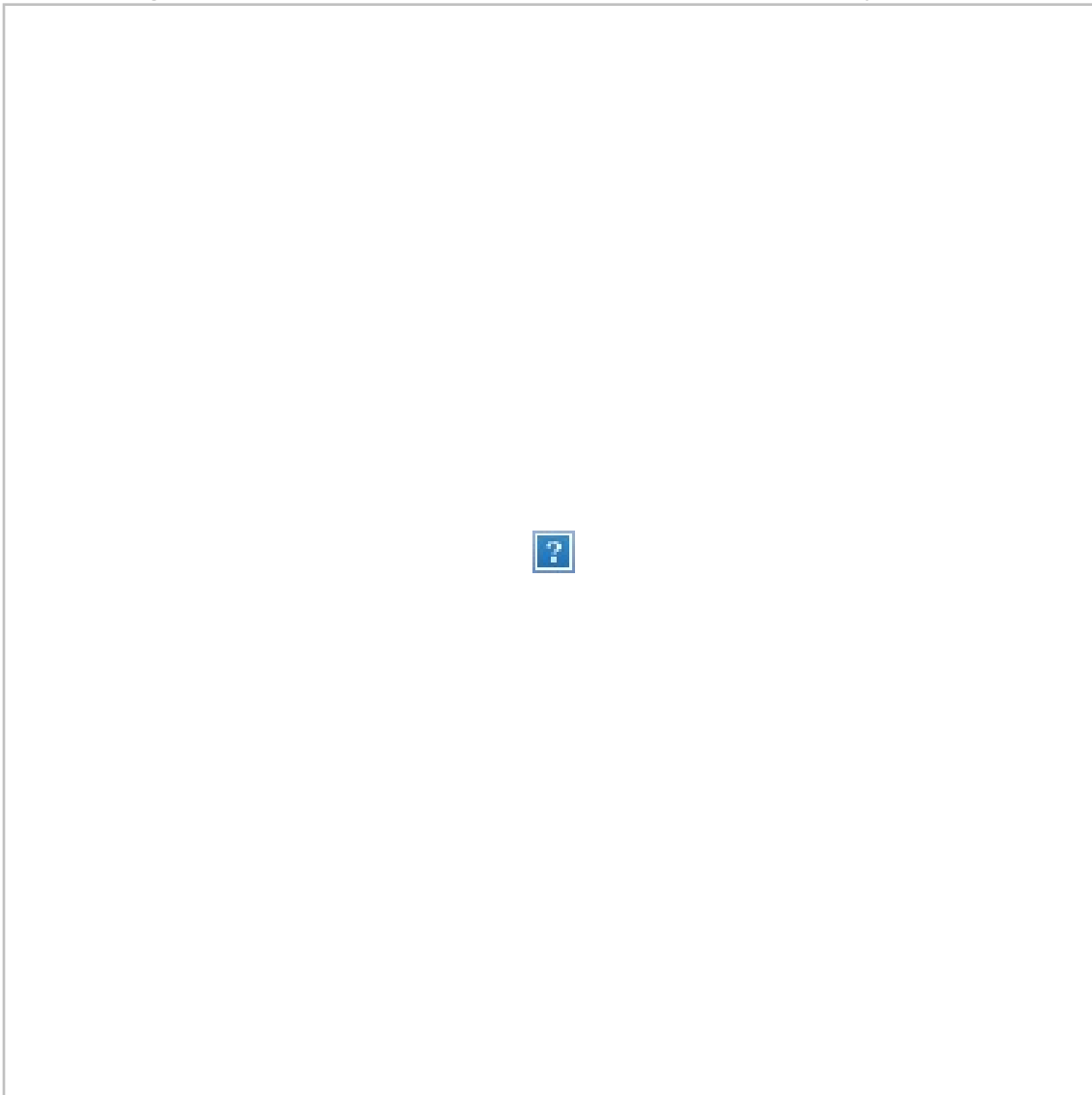

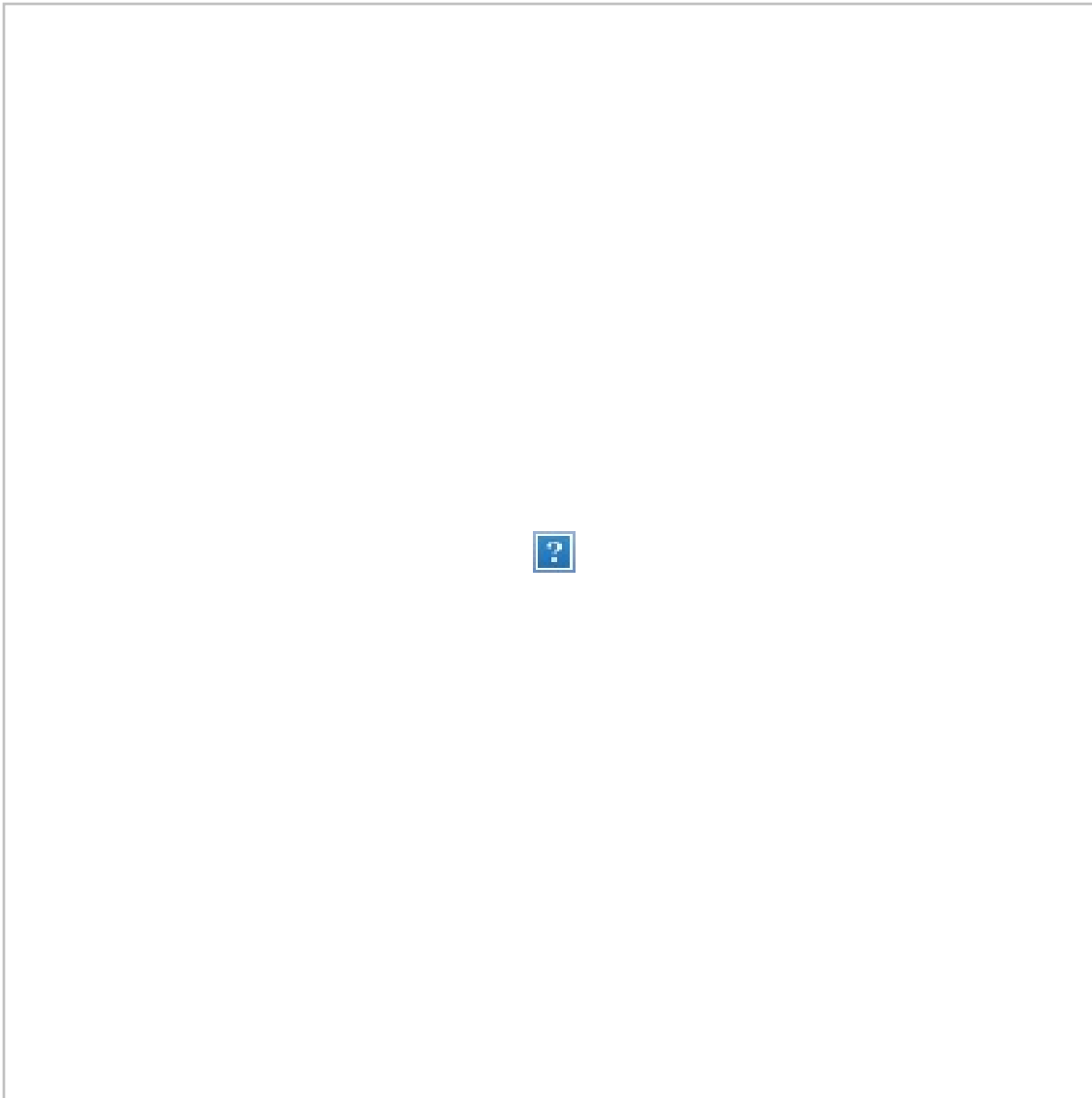

## Distance Learning tip of the week

You might find it helpful to limit the access to certain files when sharing them with other people. You can do this for any file in Google Drive by setting an expiration date. In the Share setting of your file, click on Advanced. You can then hover over the name of one of your collaborators and you'll see Set expiration with clock icon. This will allow you to set an expiration date. When you're finished click on Save changes.
