Institutional Research, Analysis and Planning Office launches new site

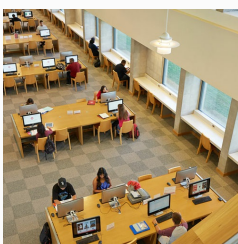

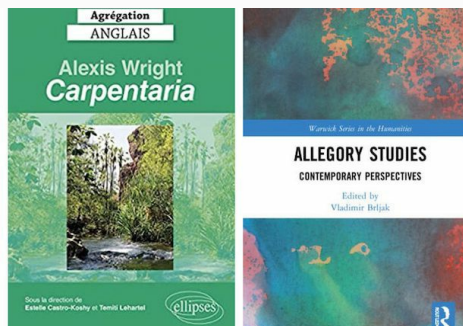
