- SMART Learning Suite (SLS): combines assessment, student collaboration, and game-based learning software into one education suite.
- SMART Notebook: for saving and sharing lessons.

- SMART Lab: for game-based activities and lessons to increase engagement.
- SMART Response 2: for assessment of student learning. Teachers can create multiple choice, true-false, or short answer questions, and students can respond from any device.
