

Decision Making Flowchart (Revised October 26, 2017)

An idea, proposal or recommendation that has **campus-wide impact** can be presented to the Chancellor's Advisory Council (CAC) by Academic Affairs (VCAC), Student Affairs (SALT), Administrative Services group and the Continuing Education Advisory Group for vetting. Any group can make a recommendation to the CAC. An open forum will be convened, if needed, for further discussion and the CAC will make a final recommendation to the Chancellor.

If the AGOs (Faculty Senate, Student Congress, Staff Council and Kalāualani) initiate a proposal or resolution that has campus-wide impact, the Chancellor may bring it to the CAC for discussion. If the proposal or resolution only impacts one AGO and its constituency, the Chancellor responds directly only to the AGO.

The Chancellor makes the final decision. If the decision is not in agreement with the recommending bodies, the Chancellor will provide a written explanation.

Note – If there is a need for revision of the idea, proposal or recommendation at any point in the process, it can cycle through the process. However, an idea, proposal or recommendation can go through this process only twice. At that point, a decision will be made by the Chancellor or tabled.
