COST OF COURSE

\$7.50 fee (for food, nursing supplies and book rental)
Uniforms—as specified by school

LENGTH OF COURSE

39 weeks including—

9 weeks classroom instruction, Monday through Friday from 8 to 3:30.

30 weeks practical nursing experience in affiliating hospitals and homes including two to three hours of class each week.

ENROLLMENT

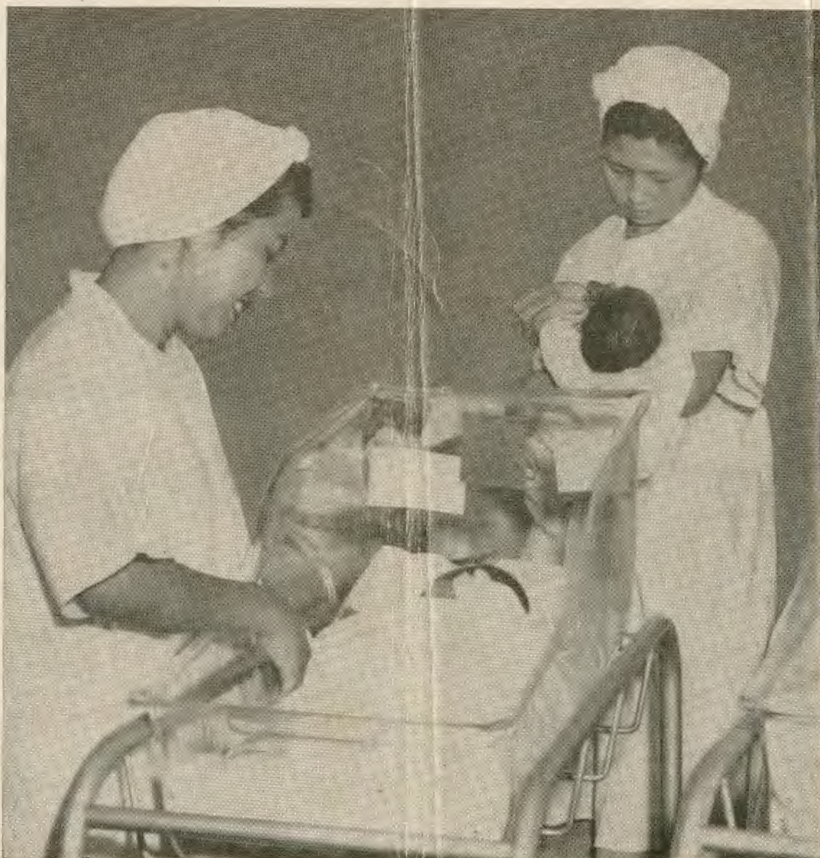
Three classes will be accepted each year. Entrance dates furnished on request. Classes limited to 24 students each. Applications must be made in advance.

CERTIFICATE OF GRADUATION

At completion of course.

Graduates are eligible to take the Licensing Board examination for Practical Nurses.

After graduation students will be privileged to wear the school cap with the uniform of the school.
