Hi Susan:

You have asked great questions. I hope you do not mind that I answer to everyone. I think it is important for everyone to know the answers. Others may be wondering the same thing.

Q: *If we have one individual speaking on our behalf, will that person have only 30 seconds per ARF (2 min total) to speak or 2 minutes per ARF (8 minutes total)?*

A: Each ARF request can have a person speak for 2-minutes. Since LLR has 4 ARFs, the total time will be 8-minutes.

Q: *Is there an agenda so we know where our ARFS fall in the order of business?*

A: Right now there is no agenda in terms of order. I still don't have all the ARFs, so I could not send out an invitation to everyone who submitted an ARF. I am hoping I get a final list today. If I do, I may send out an invitation for individuals to select a time slot.

Q: *Is each AGO allowed one question per ARF (up to 4 questions total), or are AGOs as a whole allowed only one question?*

A: Each AGO representative will have an opportunity to ask questions. They may ask more than one. Keeping track of time so all AGOs have an opportunity to ask a question will be the primary factor in determining the number of questions.
