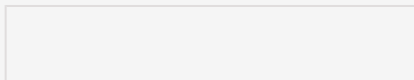
## Graduation & Commencement

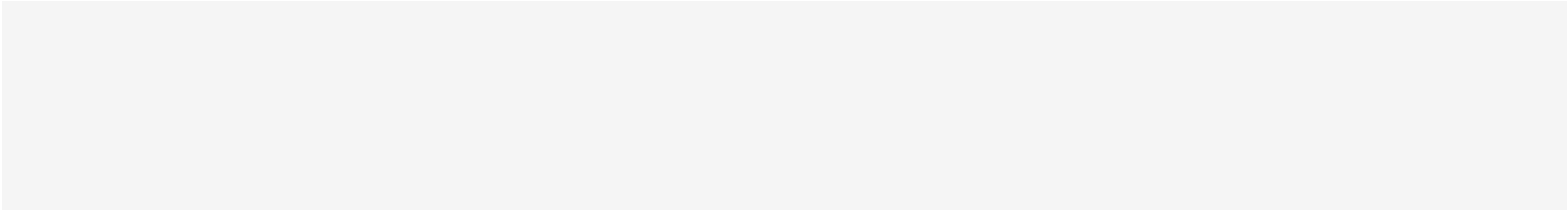
- [Graduation & Commencement](#) is the launchpad to a whole new chapter in your life. This is the place to learn what to do to prepare yourself for graduation at KCC.
