Election season reminder

University of Hawai'i employees are expected to avoid campaigning activities on UH campuses or within university facilities. Be advised that such activity is a violation of State of Hawai'i Ethics Code and Hawai'i Revised Statutes. Campaigning activity that is prohibited by state employees on state premises includes, but is not limited to: employee use of state time to engage in campaigning, using state equipment or state supplies for campaign purposes, using state premises (such as university conference rooms or classrooms) for campaign activities or meetings, or solicitation, distribution and production of campaign materials anywhere on university property.
