#### UH West O'ahu boasts double-digit enrollment increase for fall 2013

Enrollment at UH West O'ahu this fall is 2,403 students and an 18.8% increase over fall 2012. UH West O'ahu was the only UH campus to increase enrollment by double-digits with Windward CC and Kauai CC posting 2.2% and 1.3% increases respectively. All other UH campuses experienced slight decreases in enrollment.
