At the Chancellor's Advisory Council (CAC) meeting on January 16, 2018, the CAC members voted to approve the four Institutional Learning Outcomes (ILOs) as shown below:

*Within professional, civic, and personal contexts, and in the pursuit of their current individual learning goals, KCC students are able to:*

- *use critical and creative thinking and reasoning.*
- *communicate clearly and appropriately.*
- *demonstrate an active awareness of the Hawaiian Islands and the rich diversity of its peoples, in particular the values and history of the indigenous culture.*
- *make contributions to their communities.*

The final count was 25 members voted to approve, 6 voted against and there was one abstention.

The ILOs will be effective fall 2018 and will be published in the 2018-2019 catalog. Many thanks for the rich conversations around these outcomes for the institution.
