Education—eighth grade minimum. Applicants under twenty-five must be high school graduates.

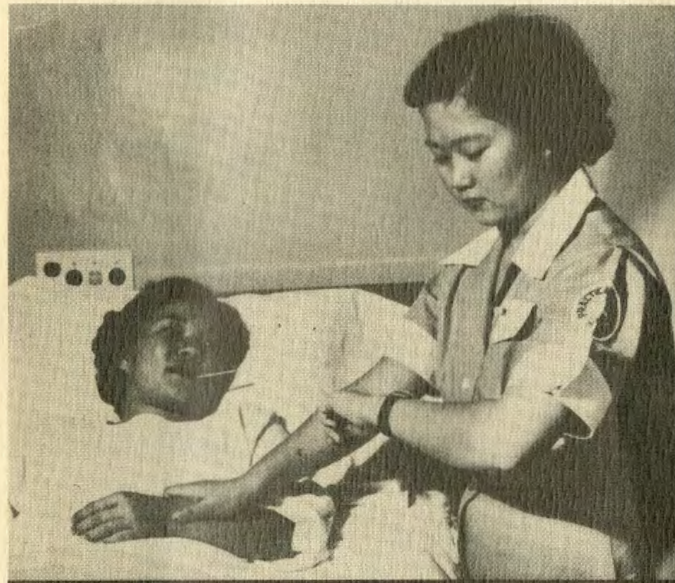
Good health—physical examination by personal physician.
