## Student Fees

- Student Activity (10 or more semester credits): \$20
- Student Activity (9 or fewer semester credits): \$2 per credit hour
- Publication: \$10

Change of Registration: \$5 – Students making in-person changes to their class schedule (including adding or dropping a class and changing grade modes) on or after the first day of instruction. Online registration changes will not incur this fee.

Late Registration – Students who register on or after the first day of instruction. This fee is applicable even when registering for special term classes beginning later in the semester.

- Spring or Fall: \$30 (as of the first day of instruction)
- Summer: \$10 (as of the first day of instruction)

## Failure to Pay Fees

Failure to pay student fees will result in a financial obligation hold placed upon your account. It will prevent you from any future registration changes, requesting an official transcript, and picking up diplomas/certificates.

## Fee Refunds

Full refund of student activity, publication, and professional program fees are given for **complete withdrawal** from all of your class(es) in the University of Hawai'i System before instruction starts or within the first week of instruction.

## Full Refunds & Withdrawal Dates (Fall 2018 & Spring 2019)

### Fall 2018:

- For semester-length classes: The last day for 100% refund is Tuesday, August 28, 2018. The last day for 50% refund

is Tuesday, September 11, 2018.

- For modular classes (classes outside of semester-length classes) last day for 100% refund is the day before class starts; last day for 50% refund is 20% of the term.

## Spring 2019:

- For semester-length classes: The last day for 100% refund is Tuesday, January 15, 2019. The last day for 50% refund is Wednesday, January 30, 2019.
- For modular classes (classes outside of semester-length classes) last day for 100% refund is the day before class starts; last day for 50% refund is 20% of the term.

## Switching Class Sections

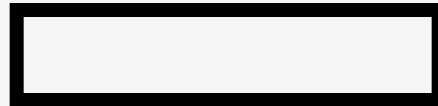
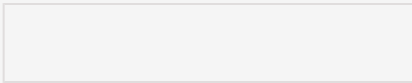
Adding or dropping of classes will be subject to the appropriate refund schedule.

## Failure to Officially Drop a Class

You will not be dis-enrolled from classes if you register after any published tuition deadline. If you have not paid for tuition/fees, did not officially drop a class that you have stopped attending, or never attended:


- You will be held responsible for payment of the tuition/fees unless you drop your classes **within the stated refund deadlines** for each class;
- A financial obligation hold will be placed on your record (after 30 days of the start of the instruction), even if you do not attend the class;
- You will receive a failing grade for the class.
