UH System President M.R.C. Greenwood discusses UH West O'ahu transition

On Feb. 1, UH System President M.R.C. Greenwood addressed UH West O'ahu faculty and staff in the Campus Center Multi-Purpose Room to share her plans, listen to concerns, and answer questions. She congratulated Chancellor Awakuni for his tremendous efforts in opening the new campus in Kapolei and shared some of her thoughts about a transition plan following his retirement. President Greenwood reassured faculty and staff that UHWO is in the right place at the right time and that there is much opportunity ahead. Part of her plan is to recommend a chancellor for a specific term that will work closely with faculty to address WASC/academic issues. She will be presenting a plan to the UH Board of Regents on Feb. 21. Upon approval from the board, the new chancellor will work alongside Chancellor Awakuni from March through May prior to the Chancellor's retirement in June. Chancellor Awakuni praised President Greenwood for taking the time to address UH West O'ahu faculty and staff directly and for her support of the new campus.
