* Resident tuition cost is \$3,084/year (\$1,542 semester) full-time/12 credits or \$128.50 per credit

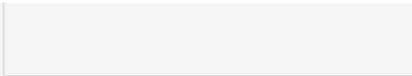
Pacific Island tuition cost is \$4,626 per year (\$2,313 per semester) full-time/12 credits or \$192.75 per credit

Non-resident tuition cost is \$8,220 per year (\$4,110 per semester) full-time/12 credits or \$342.50 per credit

** New non-resident students add one time \$25 application fee.

*** Effective July 1, 2011, cost of attendance will include only an allowance to cover basic expenses incurred for board (not room) for students living in housing provided on a military base or for which a basic living allowance is provided.

Upon student's request, additional costs for books/supplies required for certain majors, documented child care, neighbor island travel allowance and/or educational expenses related to disability that is not provided by other assisting agencies may be considered for the Federal Direct Loan Program.
