Updated Rubric:

Student can develop an accurate STAR academic plan that reflects: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - planned courses are in sequence - a plan for necessary prerequisites - graduation exceptions are documented in STAR notes - program requirement (including developmental education requirements) - declared correct major or educational goal 	Student cannot develop a plan that reflects all aspects of an accurate STAR academic plan.	Student cannot develop a STAR academic plan.

Sample Size
