### **Caution: Watch out for trucks crossing the UHWO entrance road**

Workshops will be held from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. in the Heleakalā Meeting Room at the brand-new Nānākuli Public Library (89-070 Farrington Highway Waianae, HI 96792). Topics include conducting research through the Hawai'i State Library System, how to find and use oral histories

and newspapers, how to conduct archival research, and how to preserve your research. Representatives from the local archives are being invited to attend the September 20 workshop to talk story with participants about what their collections can offer patrons.
