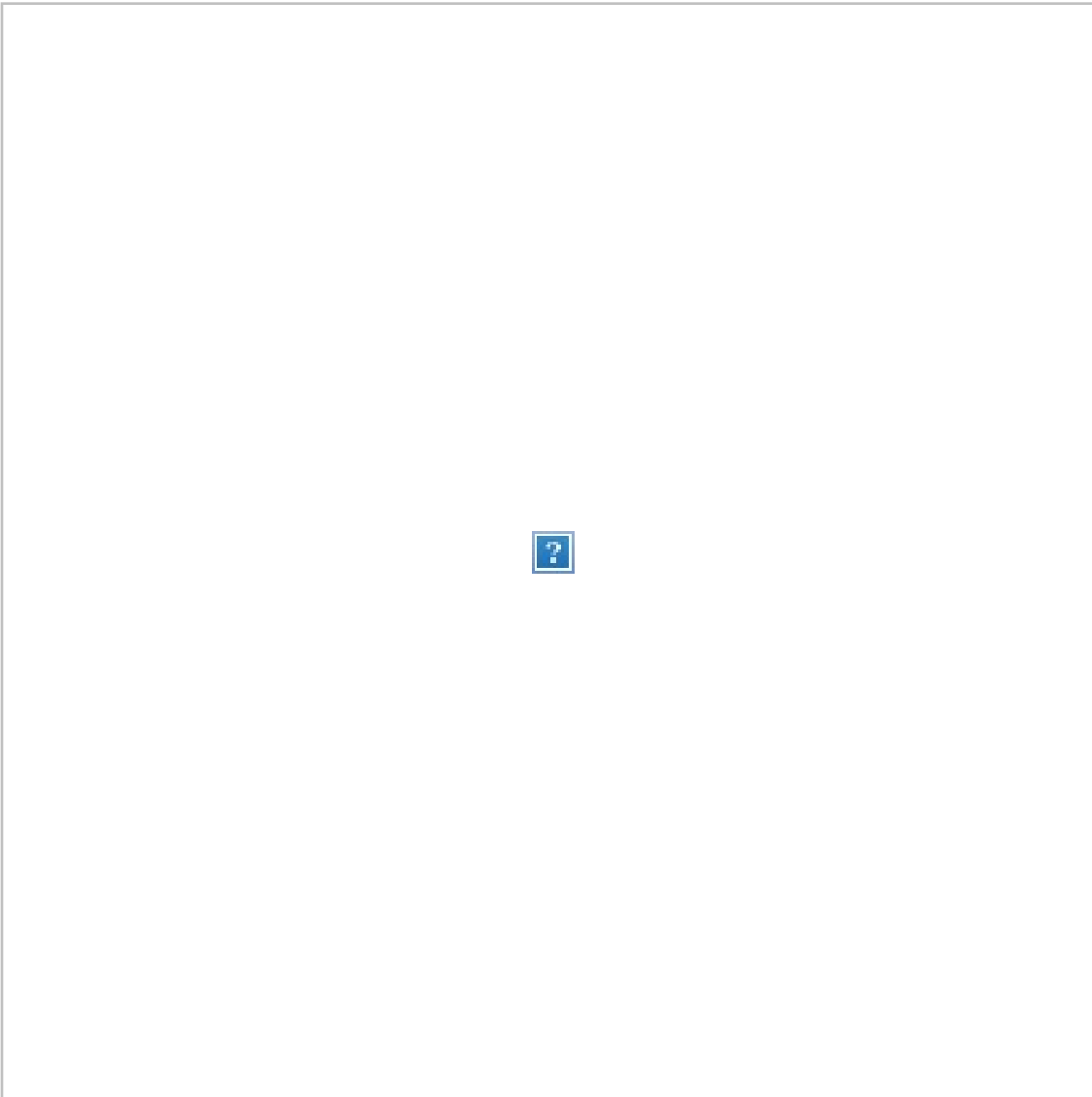

UHWO Alums, student win national cybersecurity challenge

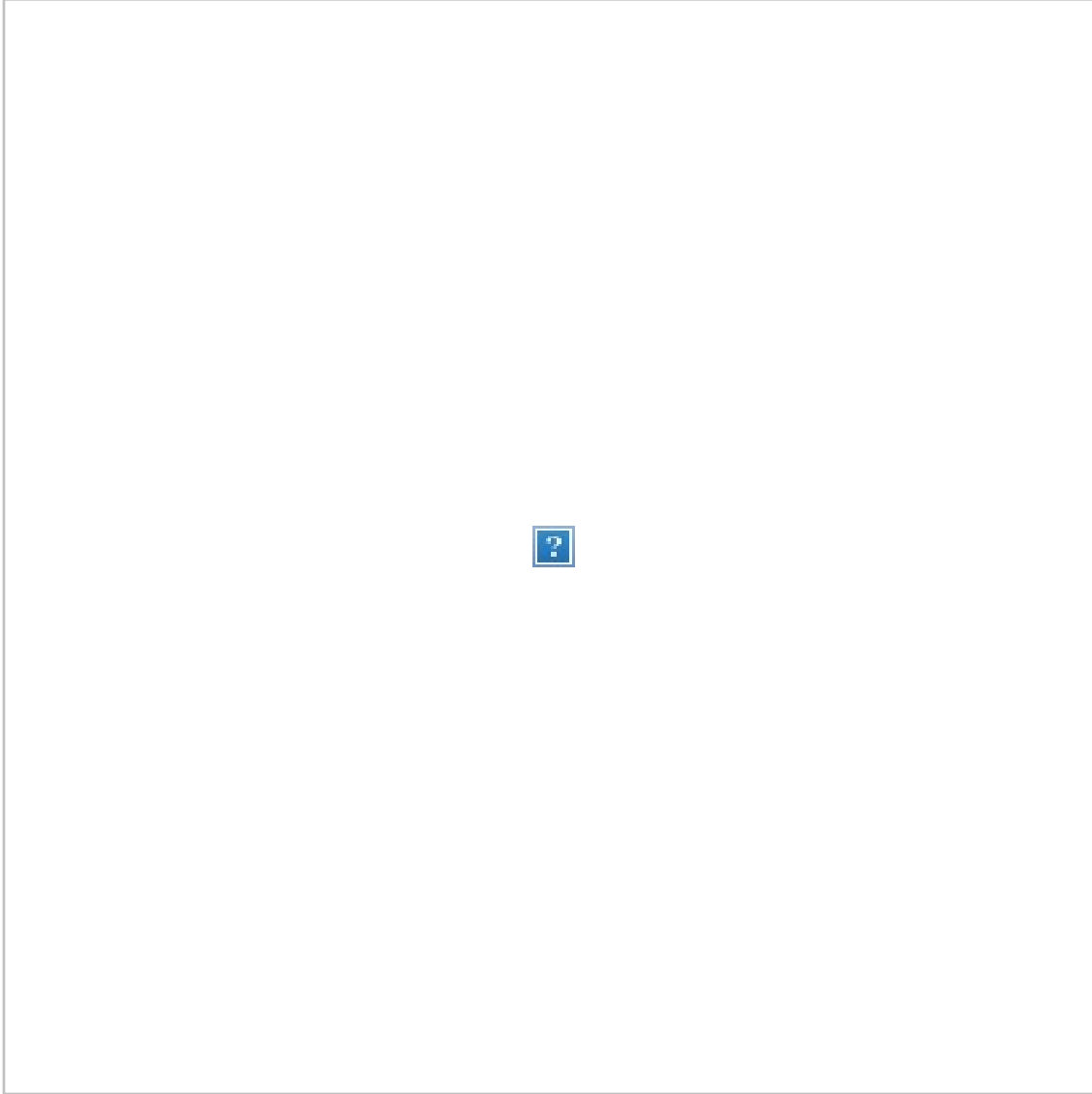

For the second time in three years a team from UH West O’ahu alumnae and a student won the National Cyber League competition, considered to be the country’s leading collegiate educational cybersecurity challenge. In late April the group known as Validity outperformed 263 other teams to take the top spot in the Spring 2018 competition. Two other groups from Hawai’i — the Grey Hats team from University of Hawai’i at Mānoa and another team from UH West O’ahu — finished

fifth and 17th respectively.

Legislative Recap - UH West O'ahu receives appropriations



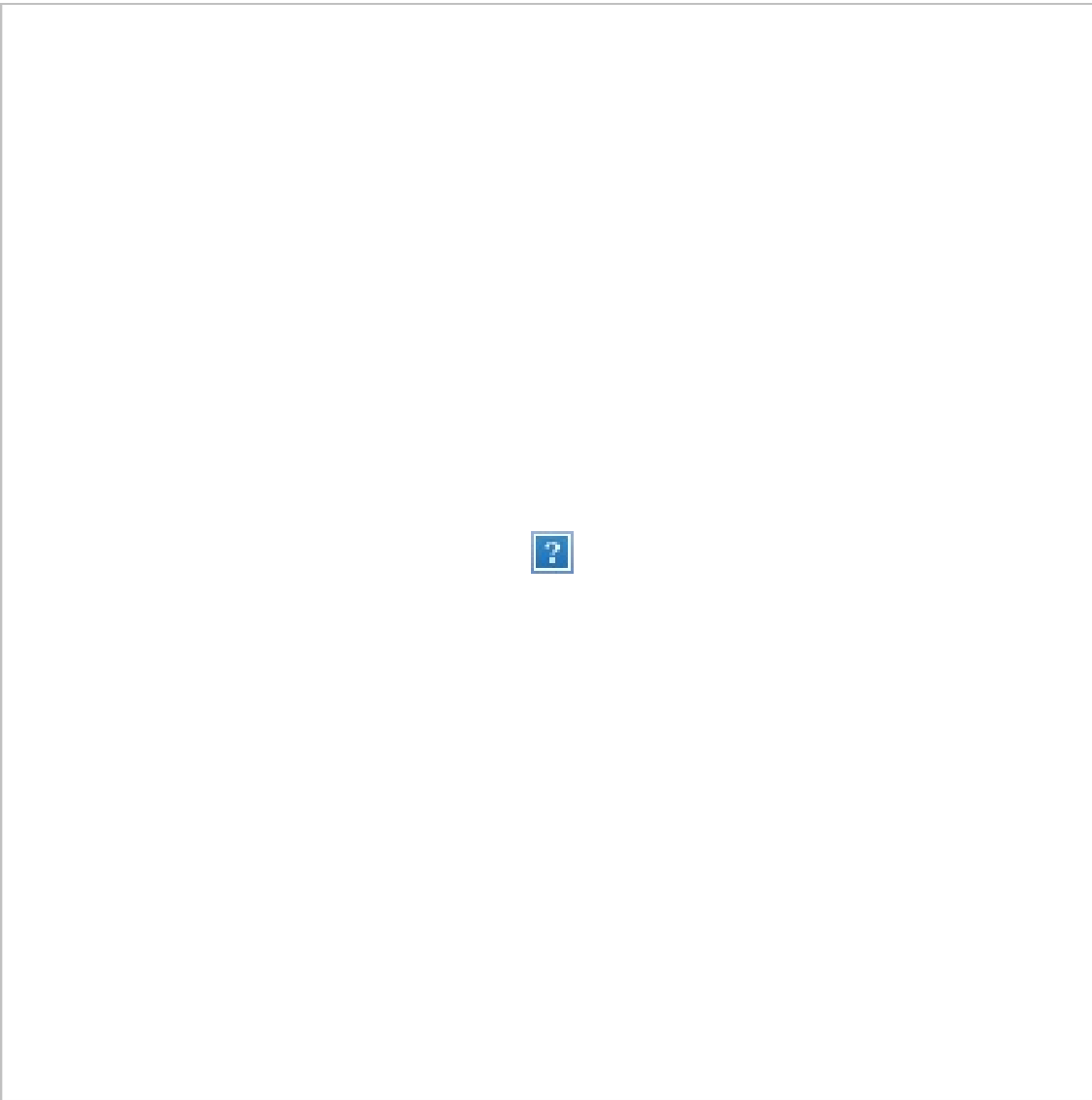
The Hawai'i State Legislature adjourned its 2018 session earlier this month, passing a supplemental budget bill that included money for UH West O'ahu. Specific appropriations for the campus included \$501,000 for Health and Safety/Utilities/Equipment, and \$515,000 for a Health Sciences Academy. The capital improvement project portion of the budget featured a \$5 million appropriation for a Campus Center Extension.

There were several initiatives and requests that went unfunded, such as the relocation of the Dental Hygiene Program from UH Mānoa to UH West O'ahu and money for Academic Affairs restructuring and growth.

Rail-related work forces closures on Kualaka'i Parkway

Work on the Keonea'a (UH West O'ahu) rail station will result in the continued closure of the left, makai-bound lane on Kualaka'i Parkway, according to Nan Inc., the station contractor. Two through lanes will remain open.

UH West O'ahu Hawai'i FoodBank Drive extended, but will end this week

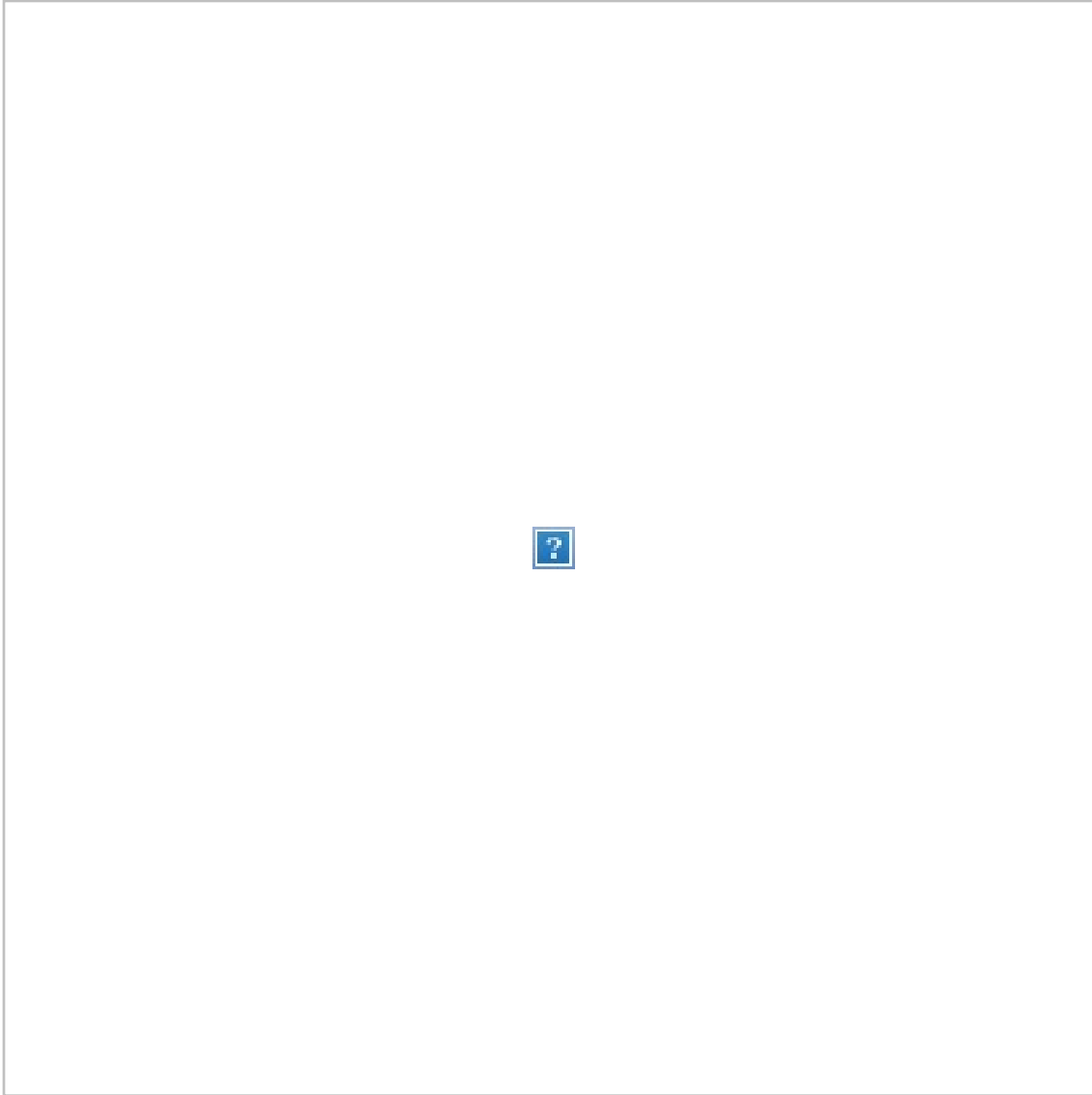

CTRL (or Command)+C for Copy and CTRL (or Command)+V for Paste are popular keyboard shortcuts that

many people use in their everyday workflow. Keyboard shortcuts are helpful because they can help you work quickly and stay focused. Some systems, like Gmail, have shortcuts that can be used specifically within the system.

Google has created shortcuts for many of the different apps. However, before you can access them, you have to activate the setting.
