Waikīkī and downtown Honolulu.

Our modern campus is architecturally integrated with its beautiful natural surroundings. The building names serve as a reminder to students of the natural environment and reference native plants that are either endemic or indigenous to Hawaii. Some of buildings have their namesake plant at the entrance.

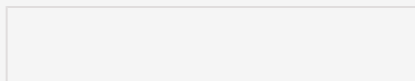
FOR ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOL GROUPS of 10 or more (up to 40 students maximum)
